Congratulations to the Class of 2017 and their Families,

Our hope is for all graduating seniors to have an enjoyable and rewarding finish to their tenure as students in the Belvidere Community Unit School District #100. I ask you to carefully review the following information to ensure a smooth finish to the year.

Graduation will be at Rock Valley College in the Physical Education Center on Saturday, May 13th at 2:00 p.m. All graduates are expected to be at Rock Valley College no later than 1:00 p.m. to begin the line-up procedure. It is important for guests to arrive at the graduation ceremony before 2:00 p.m. Once the ceremony begins, the doors will be closed and nobody will be admitted. In addition to the seating in the Physical Education Center, we will also have overflow seating available for guests who do not have tickets. The Woodward Technology Center will be available for guests to view the graduation on four projection televisions. It is located next to the Physical Education Center.

Each graduate will be given six tickets for family and friends to attend the graduation ceremony. These tickets will be given to students on Tuesday, May 9th; the last day for seniors. Students who do not need all of their allotted tickets are welcome to award them to members of the Class of 2017 who are in need of additional tickets. If additional tickets do become available, the tickets will be released on Thursday, May 11th on a first come first served basis. Information as to availability of additional tickets will be published on our website and an all call will be made to all graduating seniors by noon on Wednesday, May 10th.

A mandatory Graduation Rehearsal will be held in the Belvidere North High School gymnasium at 9:30 a.m. on Friday, May 12th. It is important that all students participating in the graduation ceremony attend the rehearsal. After we finish the rehearsal, graduates are invited to attend the annual senior picnic which will be held in Milt Brown Stadium.

Any senior who chooses not to participate in Commencement should notify Norma Garcia at 815-547-3568 or stop in the main office as soon as possible. Students who meet all graduation requirements and do not participate in the graduation ceremony will be included in the graduation program.

Students must meet all academic graduation requirements to participate in Commencement. No exceptions! Only students who have met all graduation requirements or are on track for graduation by Friday, May 5th at 8:00 a.m. will have their names included in the graduation program. In addition, seniors who engage in behavior which results in suspension may forfeit their participation in Commencement.

We look forward to celebrating this wonderful accomplishment with all of you. Illinois State Law requires vaccination of Meningococcal Conjugate Vaccine (MCV4) to all students entering 12th grade. 


