RUNNING START DUAL CREDIT PROGRAM

Students are eligible for Running Start, a program that allows select, qualified students to earn both their high school diploma and an Associate degree concurrently by attending Rock Valley College during 11th and 12th grade. All courses are held on the RVC campus and are counted as dual credit towards the high school diploma. Running Start courses are designated by RVCRS in the course title. Additionally, students may elect to take full-time college coursework in 12th grade only. These students will receive dual credit but will not earn an Associate degree.

DUAL CREDIT at BELVIDERE NORTH HS

Students have the opportunity to take courses at Belvidere North HS that earn dual credit with Rock Valley College. These courses are designated on the HS transcript by RVCD in the course title.
